


## Fairy Tale-Stone Soup



Today we will be learning about Fairy Tales. Fairy tales usually have a **problem** and a **solution**





We will also learn about the sequence of the story. The sequence is what happens in the beginning, middle, and end.


Here are some real pictures to go along with today's lesson:

Now, we are going to read the Fairy Tale,  
“Stone Soup.”





Fox was poor and hungry.  
No one would feed him.  
He had an idea.



“I will make stone soup for everyone. First, I need a big pot and some water,” he said.



Bear brought a big pot.

Get out a big pot.



Elephant brought some water.

Fill the pot with water.



Fox placed a stone into the pot of water.

Put a stone in the pot.



Rabbit brought some carrots.

Put carrots in the pot.



Mouse brought some beans.

Put beans in the pot.



Other animals brought onions.  
They brought peas and potatoes.

Put onions and potatoes in  
the pot.



The stone soup had become a feast!  
Everyone ate until they were full.

# Sequence the events in the story.


Beginning
