

# The Marklund Difference

Regulatory Standard Minimum	Marklund
Each resident shall have at least one complete bath and hair wash weekly and as many additional baths and hair washes as necessary for satisfactory personal hygiene	All clients in all homes are bathed and have their hair washed daily.
Each resident needing intermediate care shall be provided with at least 1.7 hours of nursing/personal care each day, of which at least 20% must be licensed nurse time.	Each 16 bed home staffs 84 nursing and aide hours every 24 hours. Each client gets at least 4 hours of nursing/personal care provided to them each day
Activity staff time each week shall total not less than 45 minutes per resident. This would total 72 hours of activity time per week.	Our residential Therapeutic Activity Aides are scheduled a total of 240 hours per week. We have several volunteers that come in on a regularly scheduled basis and they provide well over 1,000 hours of community service per month. These volunteers participate in group and 1:1 activities for our clients.
Each resident shall have clean bed linens at least once weekly and more often as necessary.	We change client's linens at minimum once per day.
A minimum of two adequately sized dresser drawers shall be furnished to each resident and at least one clean pillow.	Everyone at Marklund has their own dresser and on some occasions, more than one. There are no pillow limits and most people have several pillows that they are provided with. Additionally, each bedroom is supplied with at least one television and DVD player.
Per the minimum staffing calculation for ICF/DD's we are required to have a 1:8 ratio on the first and second shifts and a 1:16 ratio on 3 <sup>rd</sup> shift	Including the nurse, CAN's, TAA's, and QIDP, we are at a 1:3 ratio during 1 <sup>st</sup> and 2 <sup>nd</sup> shifts, and 1:6 ratio on 3 <sup>rd</sup> shift.
Sufficient, appropriately qualified nursing staff shall be available, which may include LPN's and other supporting personnel, to carry out the various nursing service activities.	In the homes, the campus support 6 nurses (LPN's and RN's) on the day shift, 6 on 2 <sup>nd</sup> shift, and 3 on 3 <sup>rd</sup> shift.
Direct care staff must be DSP certified.	We only hire CNA's. We provide in house training for all of our CNA's to become DSP certified.
Ensure clients the opportunity to participate in social, religious, and community group outings	In the past we have taken our clients to Disney World, we provide weekend camping trips every weekend throughout the summer, our clients have attended Cubs, Sox, and Cougars baseball games, and also professional wrestling matches and trips to Six Flags. Our outings are conducted in natural proportions (4 or less) and we try to make them individualized based on client desires.

	<p>We also offer a variety of in house activities such as Pet Therapy, Equine Dreams, and regular sessions with Pastor Don. Our Community Integration department currently provides outings to 43 of our clients per week. Our clients are provided with the opportunity to go shopping, volunteer their time making meals for needy, and they accomplish other tasks as scheduled.</p>

<p>Physical and occupational therapy facilities are not required in an ICF/DD of 16 or fewer beds.</p>	<p>We have Physical therapists, Recreational therapists, Occupational Therapists and other therapy staff employed full time with the organization. We also have a pool on-site and our clients are given the option to regularly participate in Aquatic therapy.</p>
<p>Safety- no regulation for use of surveillance cameras.</p>	<p>We provide 24 hour surveillance of all common areas of the campus in an effort to keep our clients and staff safe at all times.</p>
<p>Programs shall provide a minimum of five hours of programming per day, excluding transportation time to and from the program.</p> <p>A separate room for hair care and grooming needs is not required in an ICF/DD of 16 or fewer beds.</p>	<p>We provide our clients with Developmental training (on-site) for six hours per day. We employ a beautician for all hair needs and we have a salon on campus. We also provide our clients with on-site dental services and we have a dental office at the Hyde Center for client use. Our medical director provided our clients with in homes services and is on campus at least once a week, more if needed.</p>
