

Using the new Marklund website!

You have probably noticed that Marklund has a new website.

Staff may access Paylocity, email, HR policies and more by **logging into the STAFF PORTAL** area on the website.

Instructions on how to log in are below AND are posted by each kiosk.

PLEASE DO NOT TRY TO RESET THE PASSWORD.

It can only be reset by the website administrator.

How to Log in to the Staff Portal section of the website at the Kiosks:

The kiosk computers will be opened to the homepage on the Marklund website:

- 1. At the top right of the home page, click on "Log in"
- 2. Type the following in the "Username" box: marklund
- 3. Type the following in the "Password" box: marklund
- 4. User the mouse to click the "Login" button
- 5. At the top right of the web page, hover your cursor over the word "Staff" and a dropdown menu will appear.
- 6. Click on the link you would like to get in to (For Example: Paylocity Email, Onshift, etc.)
- 7. Log in to other pages using your personal information
- 8. Log out of your Email, Paylocity, etc. when you are finished.

You do not need to turn the computer off when you are done.
