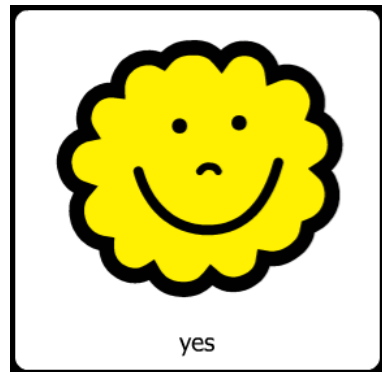
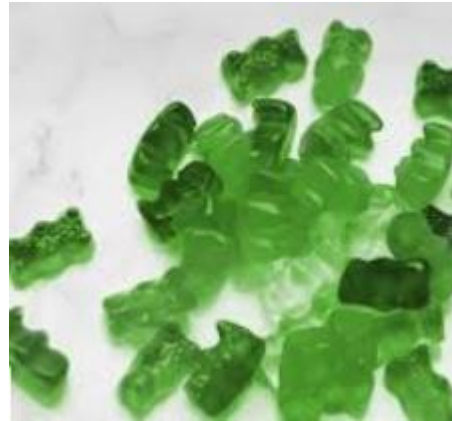


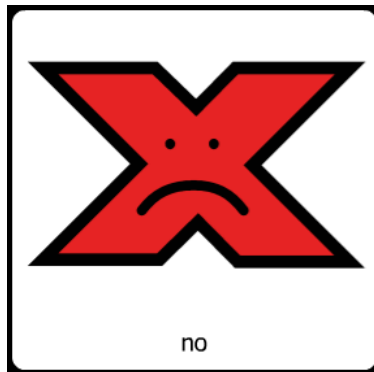

Green Eggs and Ham

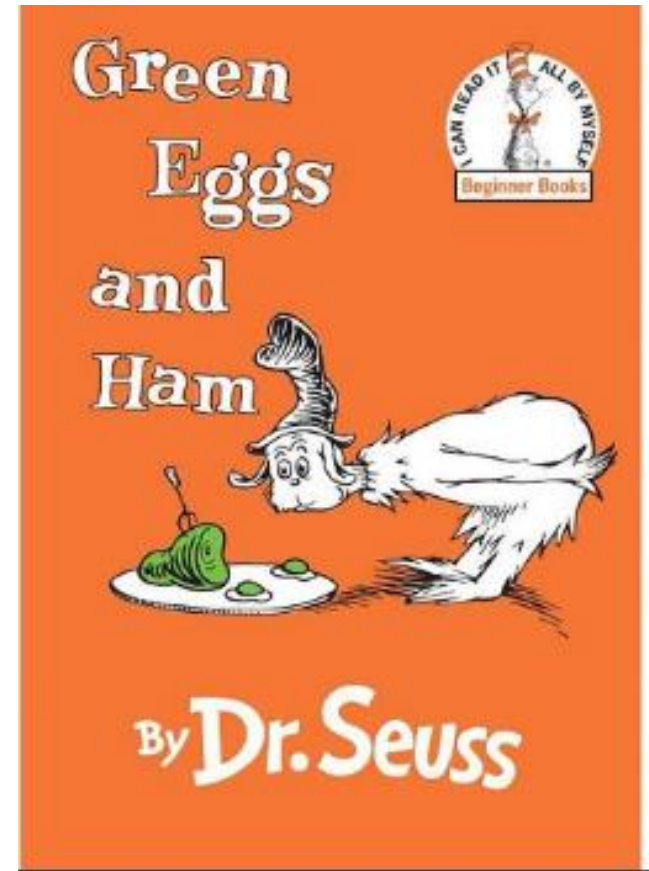
Today we will be reading Green Eggs and Ham and talking about characters and settings. Here are some pictures of what we are learning and doing.
