scissors

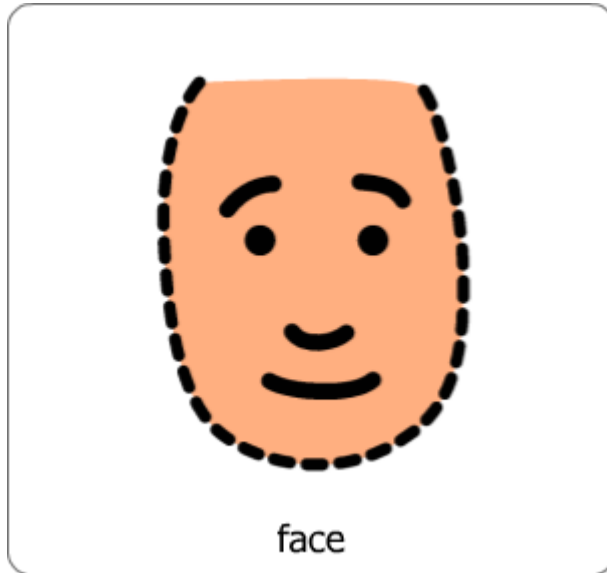


glue

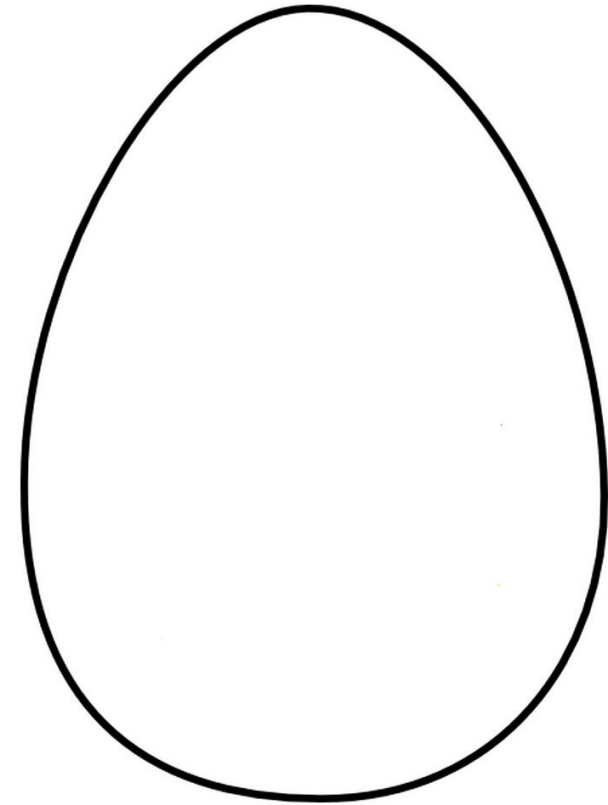
Step 1: Cut the egg from white construction paper. Now draw a face on your egg

face

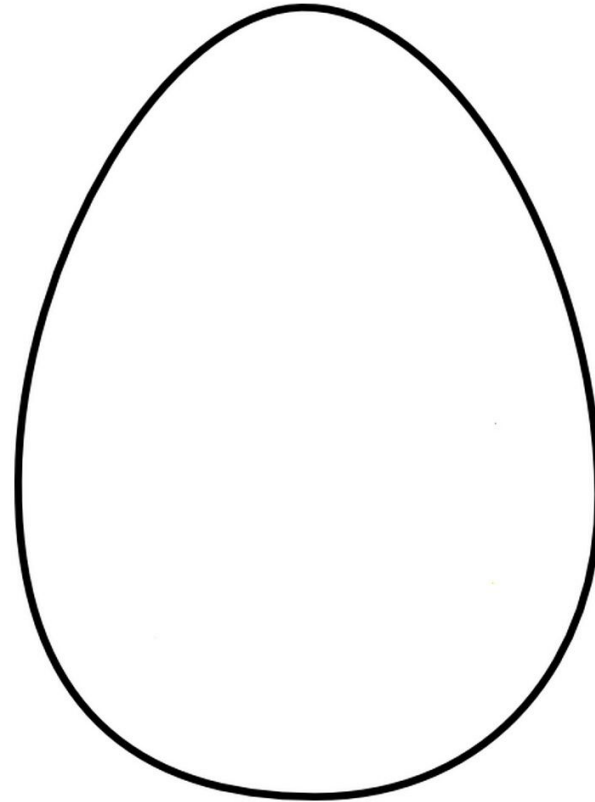




Step 2: “Break” your egg! Cut it into at least 4 pieces.

Step 4: Secure your egg by “decorating” it with Band-Aids.

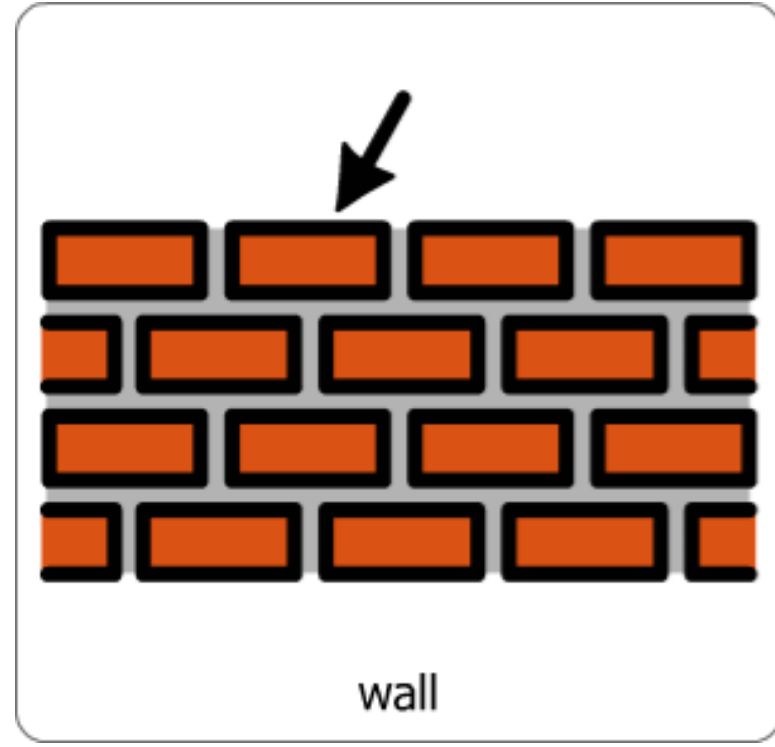
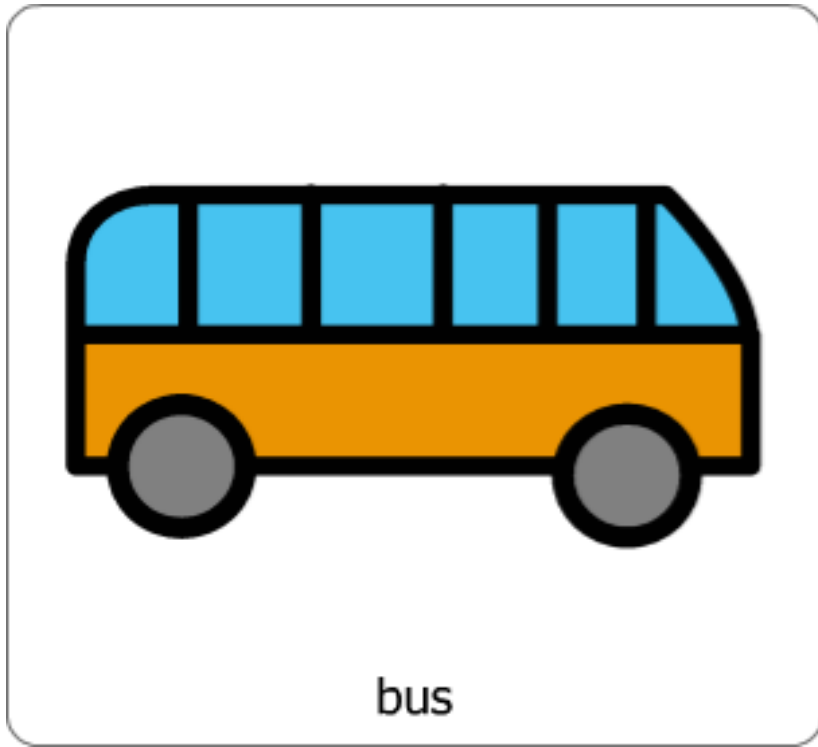
