Parts and Whole with Apples






Today we will talk about the math words "part" and "whole" using apples.






This is a whole. It means the item is in one piece.






Walk from student to student with a whole apple and have them touch "whole" picture.

This is a part. It means the item is in more than one piece.






Walk from student to student with a part of an apple and have them touch "part" picture. You will each get a turn to change your apple from a whole into parts using an apple slicer. I will model it for you first.


