Today we will be learning about identifying objects that use electricity to help us do different tasks. Here are some pictures of what we will be learning about or doing today....








How is **Electricity** used?

Energy also makes living things grow.




the flow of tiny particles called electrons and protons. It can also mean the **energy** you get when electrons flow from place to place.







Electricity is very important in our lives. Electricity makes our lives easier.







Many things in houses use electricity. Lamps need electricity to light houses at night.






We use electricity to cook. The oven, stove and microwave all use electricity.






The refrigerator uses electricity to keep our food cold.







The washing machine gets our clothes clean. The vacuum cleaner keeps the rugs clean.


