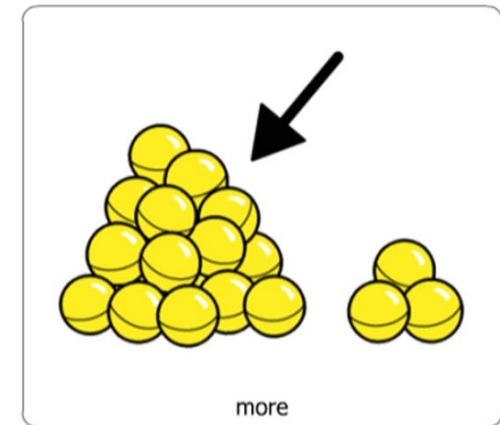
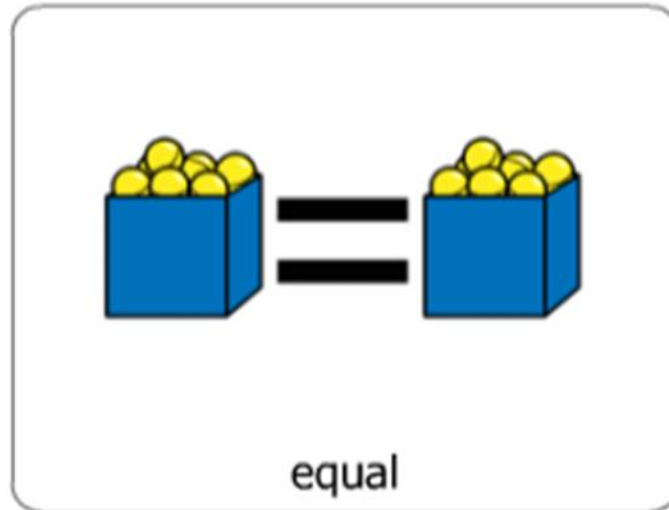
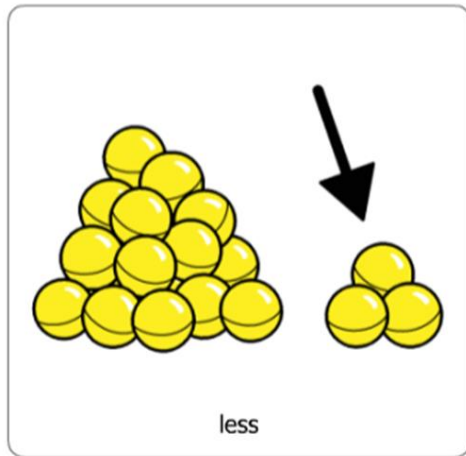
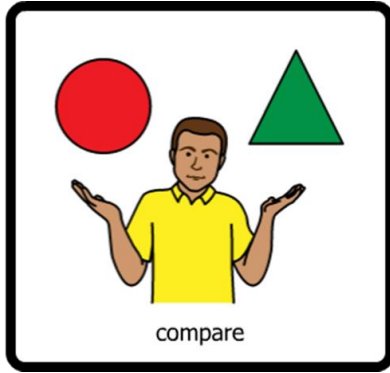
Today we will be learning about comparing amounts of objects. Here are some pictures of what we will be learning about or doing today....



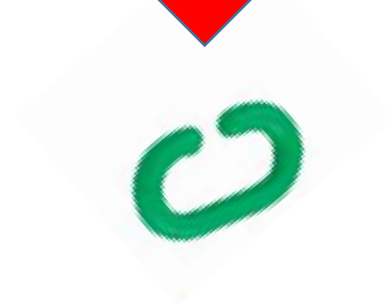
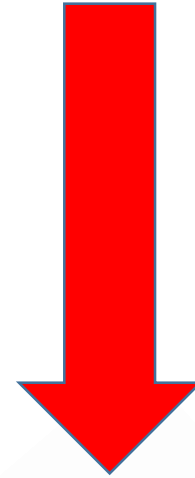
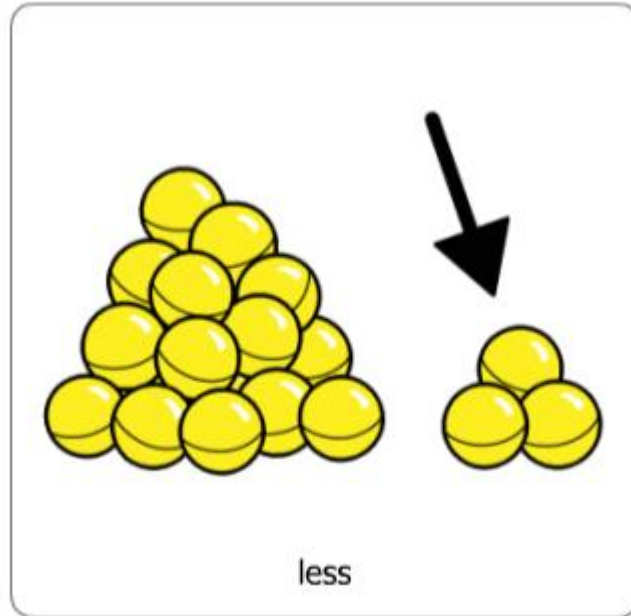
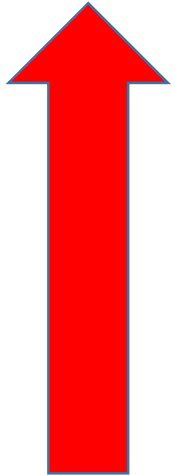

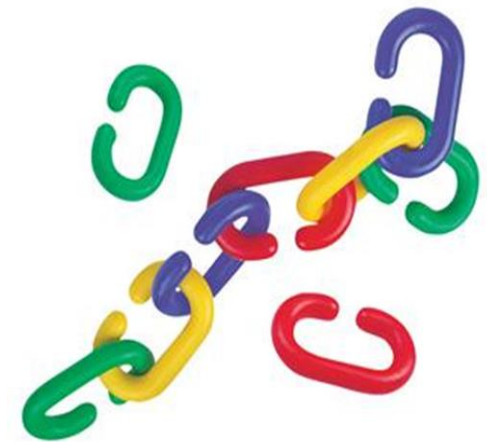
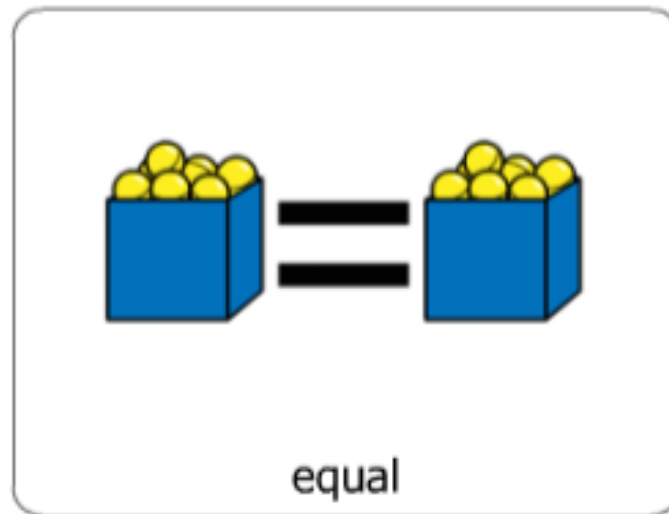
Sometimes we have **less**.



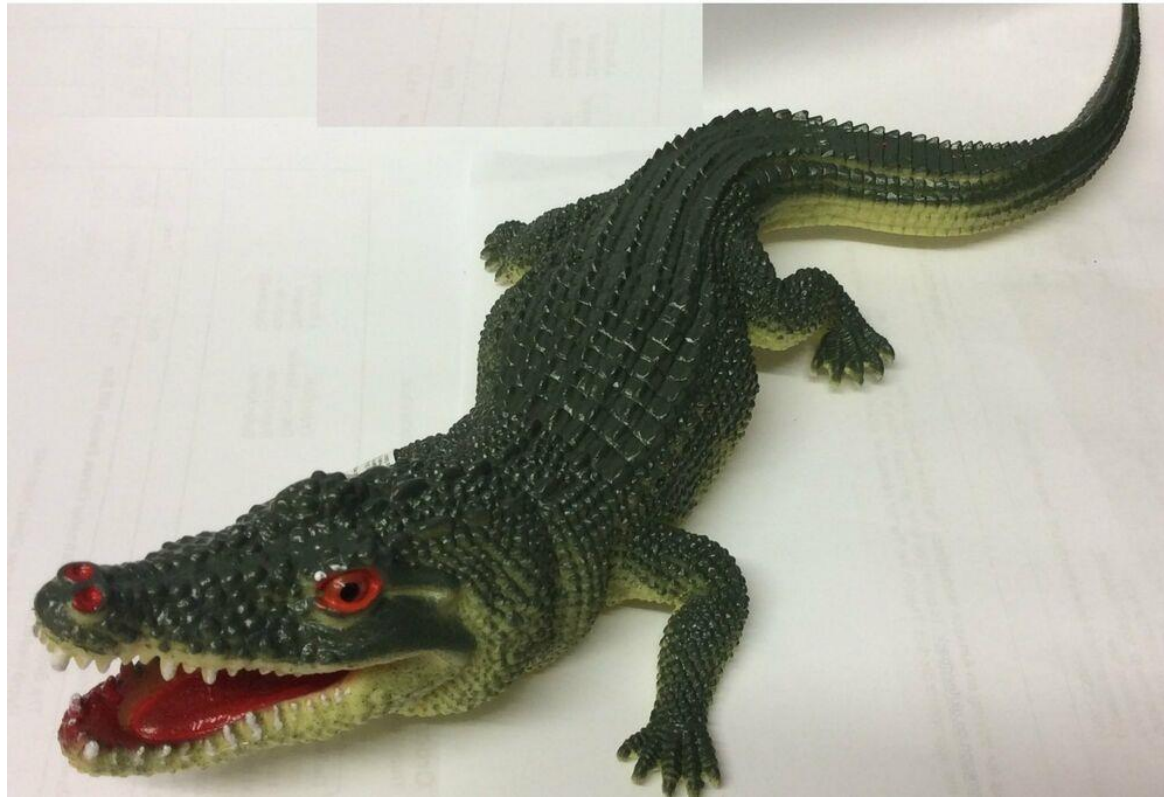
Sometimes we have **more**.



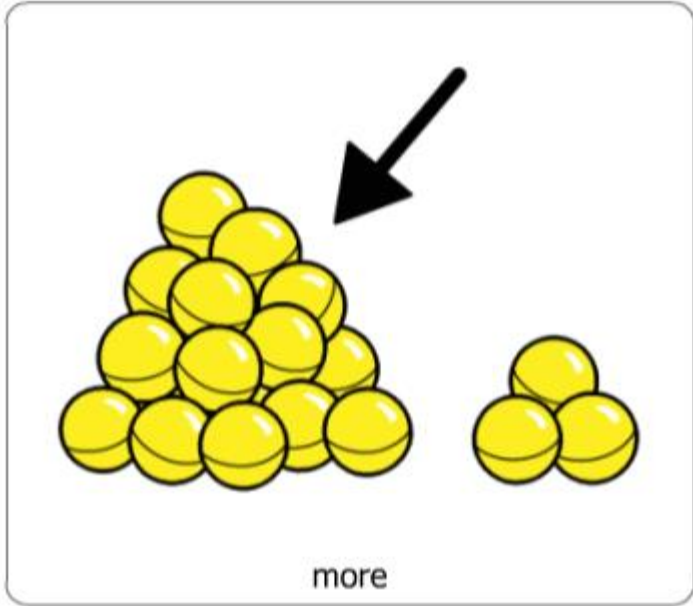
Sometimes things are **equal**. That means they have the same amount.



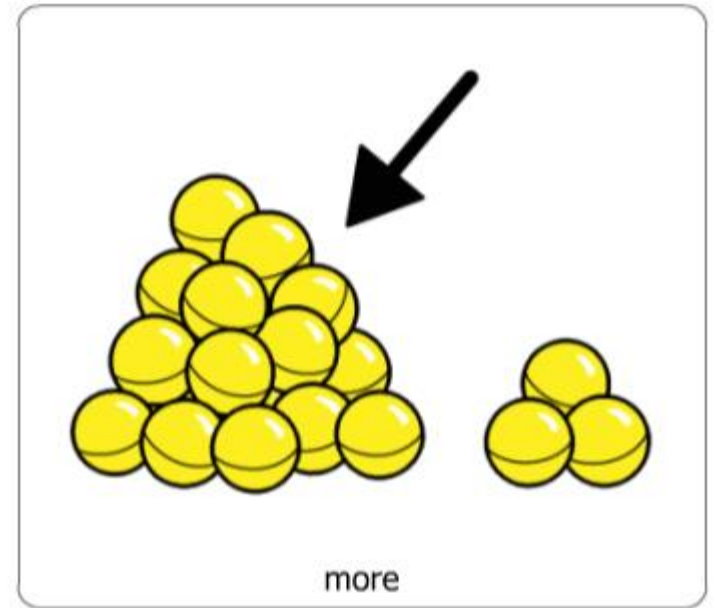
This is the hungry crocodile



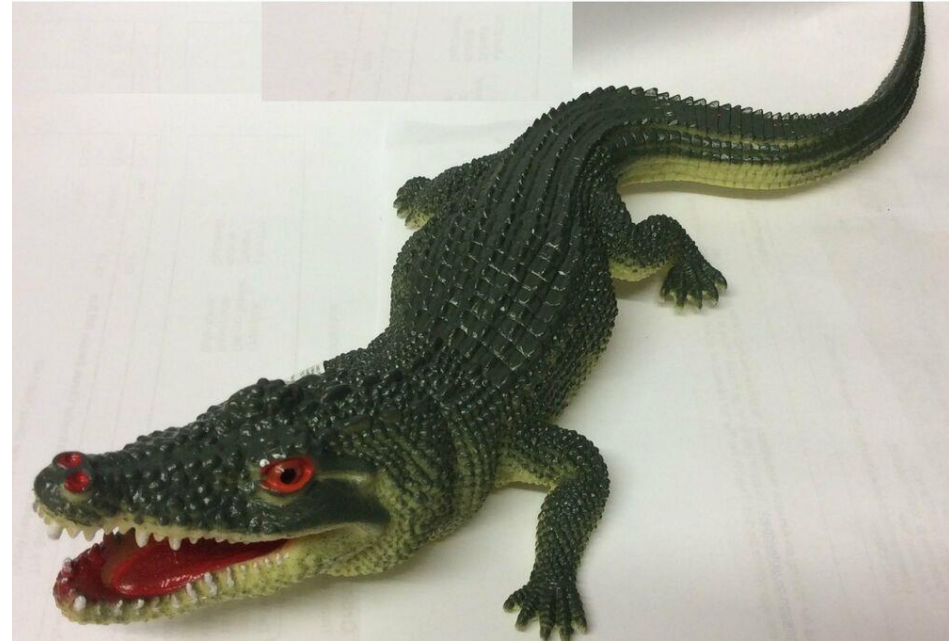
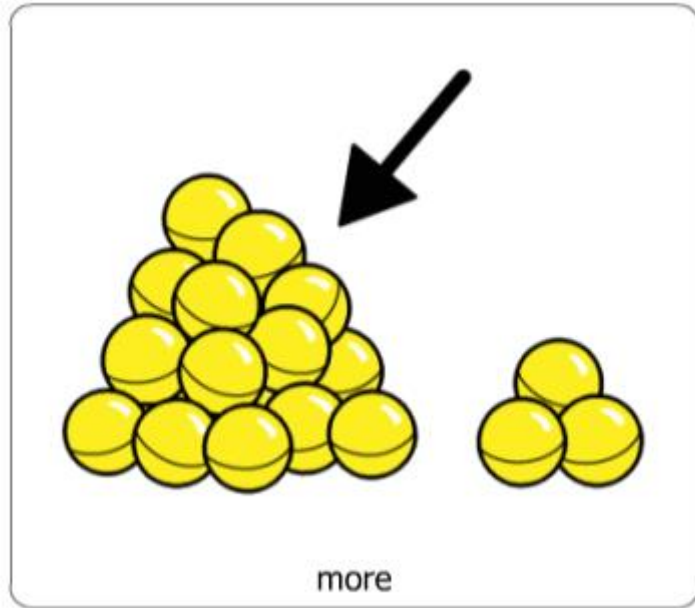
The hungry crocodile only likes to eat more.



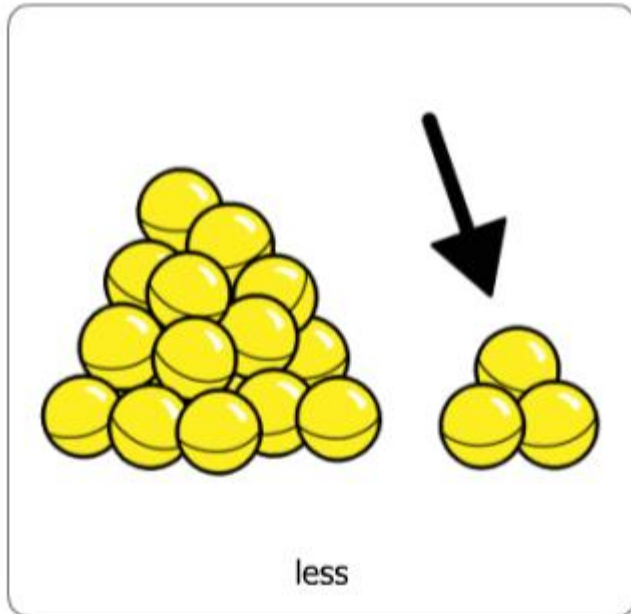
Sometimes more is to the right.



Sometimes more is to the left

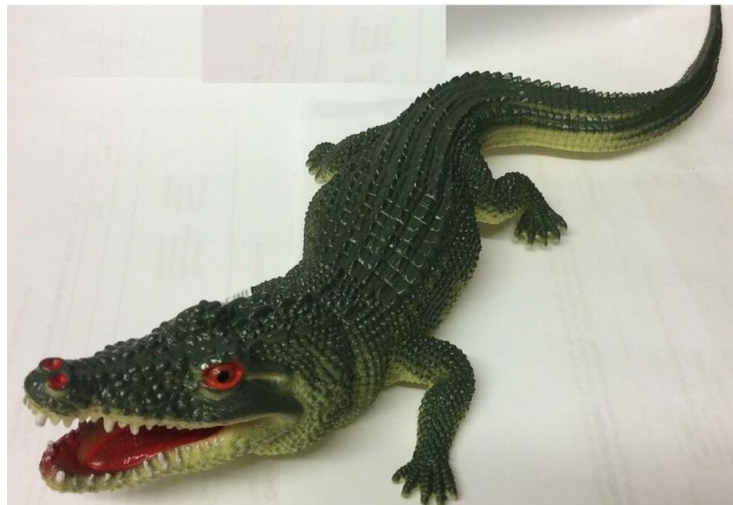
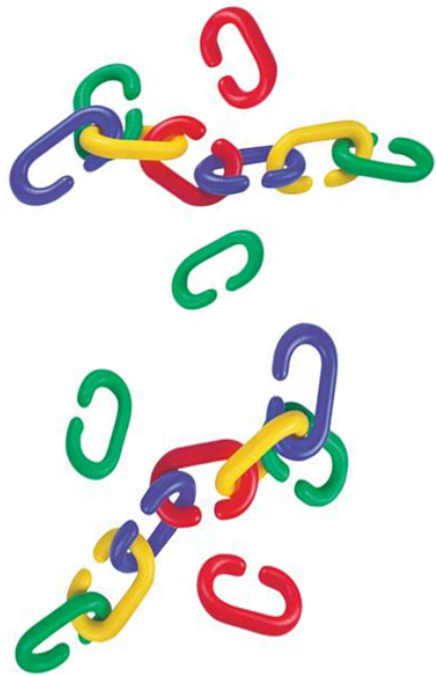


Since the hungry crocodile only likes to eat **more**... he always turns his back to **less**.

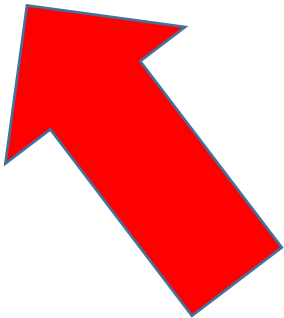
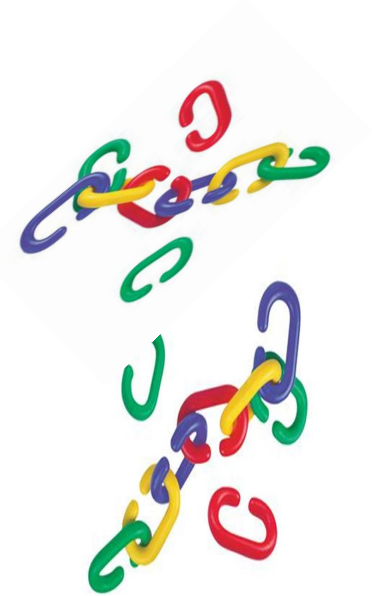


The steps for the activity are..

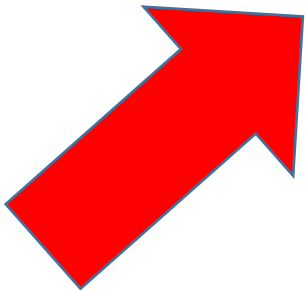
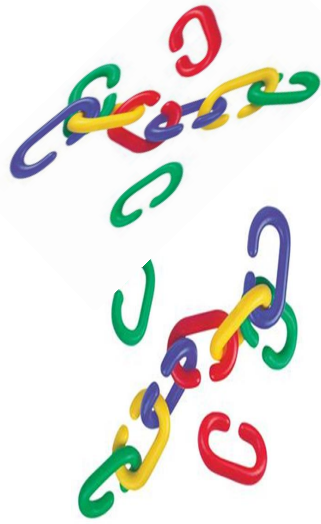
Step 1: Create two piles of chain links



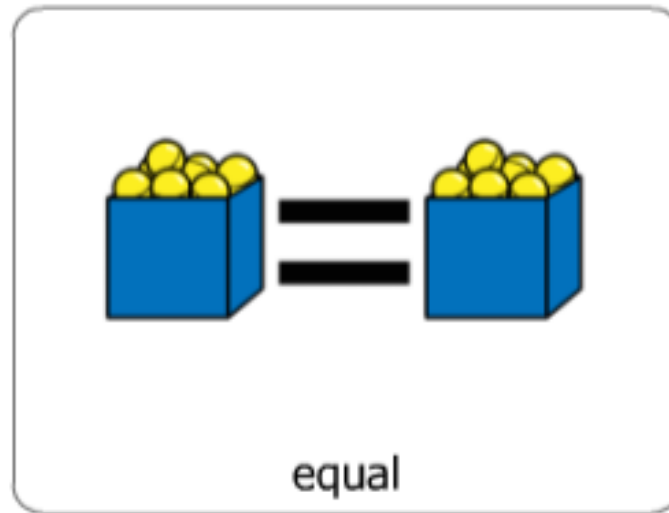
The pile behind the hungry crocodile has less



Step 2: bring out the hungry crocodile. Feed him the pile that has more.



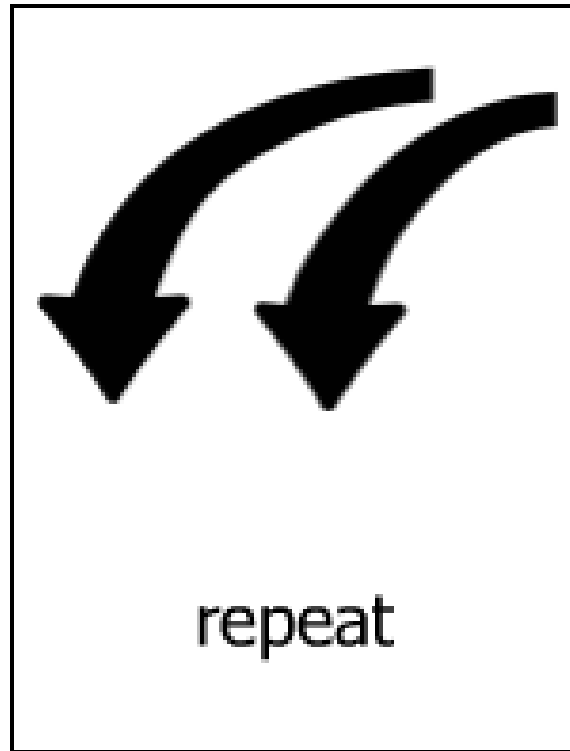
Step 3: create two piles that have the **same** amount.



When there are two equal, hungry crocodile can't decide, and he closes his mouth.



Repeat steps 1-3 with different materials and different amounts.



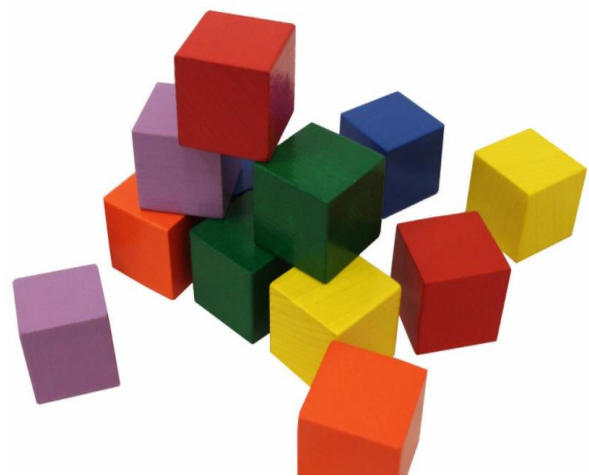
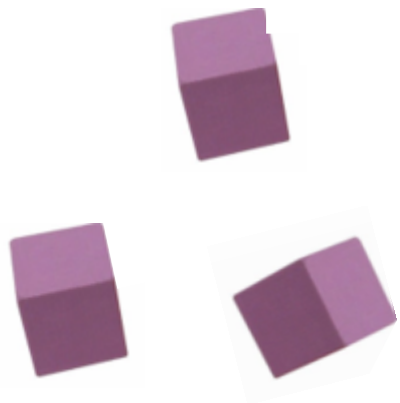
