• **Positive staff cases to report:**

In the last few days, we’ve received reports of fewer new positive cases among staff, giving us hope that the big surge Marklund has been experiencing may be winding down.

- **Wasmond Center (MWC): 1)** A direct care employee (vaccinated/not boosted) had symptom onset after working last on Thursday, Jan. 6, Rapid test completed yesterday, Jan. 9, came back positive. PCR test is pending.

- **Sayers Home (MSH), Geneva: 1)** A direct care staff (vaccinated/not boosted) felt unwell during the shift yesterday Jan. 9, and tested positive. PCR test is pending.

2) Another direct care employee (vaccinated/not boosted) reported cold-like symptoms yesterday offsite, and tested positive today via rapid. PCR test is pending. This person has not been on campus since Thursday, Jan. 6, at MSH.

Marklund Day School (MDS): An Education staff member (unvaccinated) at MDS - Geneva tested positive today during weekly mandated surveillance testing. This individual is currently asymptomatic, and had no student or staff contact.
