



Important Update re: COVID-19

- **New cases to report**

- **Sayers Home (MSH): 1** An IHR (in-house registry) direct care employee (vaccinated/not boosted/previously positive last fall) tested positive yesterday at the start of the shift. This person has very mild symptoms.

- **Philip Center (MPC): 1** A staff member tested positive after mild symptom onset. This person (vaccinated/not boosted) had only been in the Administration area of the building, had no resident contact and no close contact with staff.

- **Marklund Day School (MDS): 1** An Education staff member (unvaccinated) at the day school in Bloomingdale tested positive yesterday after symptom onset during the day. This moves one classroom into remote learning.

2) An education staff member (vaccinated/not boosted) tested positive after a work exposure, and is currently asymptomatic.

- **Hyde Center Campus (MHC) 1** An administrative staff member (vaccinated/boosted) who works at the Geneva campus tested positive for COVID today via rapid test after developing symptoms yesterday. This person did not have any contact with residents, community clients or students; contact tracing for staff is completed. PCR is pending. Was last on campus Monday, Jan. 3.

- **Resident cases in Elgin**

Three residents at MWC tested positive yesterday evening after developing mild symptoms. They are all vaccinated/boosted and resident on the North Side.

One other resident (unvaccinated) who tested positive earlier in the week has been admitted to the hospital due to the development of more severe symptoms. We pray that the resident responds as quickly to treatment as did our resident from Geneva.
