



Important Update re: COVID-19 *from Gil Fonger, President & CEO*

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New cases at Bloomingdale, Elgin and Geneva

Marklund Philip Center (MPC), Bloomingdale: A Support Services employee tested positive via PCR after symptom onset Monday night following a community exposure. This person last worked on Sunday, Aug. 21. Contact tracing determined there was no close contact with any staff or residents. While this technically puts MPC into Outbreak to Sept. 6, no residents/staff need to quarantine. All residents as well as staff who worked on Sunday have tested negative.

Marklund Wasmond Center (MWC), Elgin: A direct care staff member tested positive via rapid this morning after congestion onset last night. PCR is pending. This individual worked at MWC this whole week, and rotated through a number groups with residents from both sides of the building, as well as some of our students in the on-site MDS classroom. This puts the whole building into Outbreak to Sept. 8.

Marklund Hyde Center (MHC), Geneva: A direct care employee tested positive this morning after developing symptoms. Through contact tracing, it was determined this individual worked with residents from the Tommy Home (MTH), Haverkamp Home (MHH), and Richard Home (MRH), and as well as with three community clients over the past two days. Community Day Services (CDS) will be held in all six homes until testing is complete in order to lower transmission risk across the campus. MRH, MHH and MTH will be in Outbreak status to Sept. 8.
