One positive and many negatives

Marklund Sayers Home (MSH), Geneva: One direct care employee tested positive yesterday after symptom onset. This person last worked the day shift on Friday, Sept. 9, so this does not change MSH’s outbreak date.

Geneva and Bloomingdale statuses: All residents from MHH, MVH, MRH, and MTH have tested negative and are able to be back at Community Day Services (CDS) in Geneva. MDH residents have also recently completed two rounds of negative tests and will return to CDS on Wednesday. In addition, MPC is now out of Outbreak status.

I am pleased to also share that our administrators are in the process of scheduling on-site clinics for residents and staff to receive the new Bivalent booster. Hopefully that will help curb the spread of the virus so we can get closer to returning to normal activities.
