## History

In 1954, a pediatrician asked Claire Haverkamp, R.N. to provide foster care to an infant named Mark William Lund who was born with Down Syndrome and severe cardiac complications. Claire and her husband Stan started providing care to Mark five days later in their own home. As word spread, their family grew with many more foster children with special needs. These acts set the foundation for Marklund.

Since its founding, Marklund ensures that high-quality programs and services are available to children and adults with developmental disabilities. Recognizing the growing numbers of those in need of specialized services, and the availability of new technology to assist in serving this population, Marklund has continued to evolve and grow.

In November 2016, Marklund merged with Little Angels Center for Exceptional Care in Elgin. Having a history very similar to Marklund's, Little Angels was founded in 1958 when a nurse, Pat Wasmond, began providing 24-hour care to a child with profound disabilities. With the mission to love, care and support just like family, the agency grew into a skilled nursing residential and developmental training facility for children and adults with profound developmental disabilities.

### Six 16-bed Homes:

Licensed Intermediate Care Facility (ICF) offers 24-hour residential active treatment programs that provide for the intensive medical, social, emotional and physical needs of the 96 persons served.

**Hyde Center Building:** Community Day Services program, on-site aquatic therapy pool and spa, administrative offices, and therapy program are included on this campus.

**Foglia Education Center at Marklund Day School - Geneva:** This non-public state-certified school partners with school districts to provide a highly specialized education experience. The therapeutic, sensory-driven Multi-Needs and Life Skills programs serve individuals ages 3-22 with medical, developmental and physical disabilities, and those with autism spectrum disorders.
